SITUATION REPORT

INCIDENT NAME: F/V Tarrissa Jean C - Kodiak

SITREP #: 2 and Final

SPILL NUMBER: 04249921901

TIME/DATE OF INCIDENT: The F/V Tarrissa Jean C ran aground in Uyak Bay at about 5:00 AM on August 6, 2004 and began taking on water. The ADEC staff was informed of this grounding at 8:30 AM on August 6, 2004, while visiting the U.S. Coast Guard Marine Safety Detachment Kodiak (MSD Kodiak).

TIME/DATE OF SITUATION REPORT: 3:30 PM, August 9, 2004

TIME/DATE OF NEXT REPORT: This is the final report.

TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED: According to the owner of the vessel, no fuel release has occurred as a result of the grounding

LOCATION: Uyak Bay, Kodiak at Latitude 57 24.28N, Longitude 153 51.194W.

CAUSE OF SPILL: The cause of the grounding remains under investigation by the Coast Guard.

POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP): Mr. Douglas Waterbury, of Kodiak, the owner of the vessel. The Tarrissa Jean C is a 48 ft. fiberglass fishing vessel.

RESPONSE ACTION: The vessel has been repaired, re-floated, and taken to Kodiak Salmon Packers in Larson Bay. Larson Bay is located 5 miles north of where the vessel was grounded.

SOURCE CONTROL: No further source control actions are required.

RESOURCES AFFECTED: The grounding site in Uyak Bay. No oiled wildlife has been observed.

FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS: The investigation as to the cause of the grounding will continue by the Coast Guard.

WEATHER: Rainy, winds from the NE at 15 to 30 MPH, Temperature 57 °F
