**SITUATION REPORT**

**INCIDENT NAME:** Anna Platform Crude

**SITREP #:** 1 & Final

**SPILL NUMBER:** 05239920901

**TIME/DATE OF SPILL:** 11:15 AM on July 28, 2005 and the spill was reported to ADEC by Unocal at 11:25 am on July 28, 2005.

**TIME/DATE OF SITUATION REPORT:** 10:00 AM July 29, 2005

**TIME/DATE OF THE NEXT REPORT:** This is the final report.

**TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED:** Unocal estimates that less than 2 barrels (84 gallons) of crude oil was released.

**LOCATION:** Cook Inlet

**CAUSE OF SPILL:** Valve failure on inlet line to oil/water separator on Anna platform.

**POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP):** Unocal Oil & Gas Company

**RESPONSE ACTION:** Representatives from Unocal and Cook Inlet Spill Prevention Response Inc. (CISPRI) conducted an over flight on July 28, 2005 afternoon to locate the sheen in Cook Inlet. The incoming tide had carried the sheen to the north of Anna and Bruce platforms. The silver sheen with some brown patches of oil was mapped and the CISPRI vessel Seabulk Montana was deployed to the scene to collect any recoverable product. The sheen was dissipating rapidly and the Seabulk Montana crew was able to collect some product using viscous sweep before increasing winds and choppy seas made further recovery ineffective.

**SOURCE CONTROL:** This inlet line to oil/water separator on the platform has been isolated until a replacement valve can be located.

**RESOURCES AFFECTED:** Waters of Cook Inlet north of Anna and Bruce platforms.

**FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS:** The valve has been inspected and determined to be not repairable and will need to be replaced. Unocal is in the process of locating a new valve for this replacement.

**WEATHER:** Partly cloudy, 60° F with light winds.
